Army Cloud Computing Enterprise Transformation (ACCENT) is a contract vehicle for U.S. Army organizations to obtain commercial cloud service offerings (CSO) and related IT technical support. This contract supports Army Data Center Consolidation Plan (ADCCP) modernization and migration objectives to transition designated Army IT applications, systems and associated data to authorized commercial cloud service providers (CSP) or an Army Enterprise Data Center (AEDC).

ACCENT Basic Ordering Agreements (BOAs) enable Army capability owners to obtain commercial cloud hosting services in any combination of service and deployment models and Cloud Impact Level authorizations, as defined in the Department of Defense (DoD) Cloud Computing Security Requirements Guide (SRG). In addition, the contract provides transition support and modernization services required to move a system or application to a cloud environment or AEDC and optimize it. Cloud solutions also include mobile capabilities to meet urgent Army needs in contingency situations.

Cloud Service Models (CSM) covered under the ACCENT scope include Infrastructure as a Service (IaaS), Platform as a Service (PaaS), and Software as a Service (SaaS). Cloud deployment models include private, community, public and hybrid, as applicable. Task Order contracts awarded under the BOAs may be for one or more cloud service models and cloud transition support services


to meet the requirements of mission owners across the Army. Cloud hosting solutions may require either on-premise or off-premise hosting and support hosting of system and application data at Cloud Impact Levels 2, 4, 5 or 6.

How to use ACCENT

Working in partnership with the prime contractors, the Army's Computer Hardware, Enterprise Software and Solutions (CHES) manages the contract in coordination with Army Contracting Command-Rock Island (ACC-RI). Through ACCENT, users can meet IT service needs quickly, efficiently and cost-effectively. Any contracting office can place orders, and there is no fee to place orders against the ACCENT contract.
